The North Farmersville bridge project and closure has been postponed. Originally scheduled to take place beginning in the fall of 2017 the construction and closure have been postponed to 2018 as part of PennDOT's Rapid Bridge Replacement Project.

Construction is tentative to begin early June 2018. During this time, drivers will be directed to follow a detour along Diamond Station Road/Tobacco Road (Route 1022), Old Akron Road (Route 1041), Route 272 (Oregon Pike), Route 772 (Glenbrook Road), and Route 23 (Main Street). The bridge is anticipated to be complete by August 2018. This schedule is subject to change.

This bridge is referred to as JV-265 and is one out of the 558 bridges being replaced under the Rapid Bridge Replacement Project. JV references the joint-venture partnership between Walsh/Granite, which is leading construction for the entire project.
