§ 29-1. Establishment of Park and Recreation Board.

There is hereby created a Park and Recreation Board in and for the Township of West Earl. The Park and Recreation Board shall consist of five persons to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors.

§ 29-2. Appointments; terms of office; vacancies.

The members of the Park and Recreation Board shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors for terms of five years or until their successors are appointed. The members of the Park and Recreation Board first appointed shall be appointed for such terms that the term of not more than two members shall expire annually thereafter. All persons appointed to the Park and Recreation Board shall serve their full terms unless the member shall voluntarily resign or shall be removed by the Board of Supervisors for dereliction or neglect of duty. Vacancies occurring on the Park and Recreation Board occurring otherwise than by expiration of a term of a member shall be filled for the unexpired term only.

§ 29-3. Service without pay.

The members of the Park and Recreation Board shall serve without pay.

§ 29-4. Election of officers.

The members of the Park and Recreation Board shall elect their own Chairman and Secretary and shall select all other necessary officers to serve for a period of one year.

§ 29-5. Meeting schedule.

The Park and Recreation Board shall meet on an as-needed basis.

§ 29-6. Authority, powers and duties.

The Park and Recreation Board shall serve as an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Park and Recreation Board shall perform such services as shall be requested by the Board of Supervisors.
