ARTICLE I

Water Authority

[Adopted 3-29-1956 as Ord. No. 3]

§ 6-1. Legislative intent; statutory authority.

The Board of Supervisors of this township hereby signifies its intention to organize an Authority under the provisions of the Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, as amended.¹

§ 6-2. Execution of Articles of Incorporation.²

The President and Secretary of the Board of Supervisors are hereby directed to execute on behalf of the Township of West Earl Articles of Incorporation for said Authority.³

ARTICLE II

Sewer Authority

§ 6-3. Legislative intent; statutory authority.

The Board of Supervisors of this township signifies the intention and desire to organize an Authority under the Pennsylvania Municipality Authorities Act of 1945, approved May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, known as the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945" (the "Act"), as amended and supplemented,⁴ for the purposes of exercising any and all powers conferred by the Act.

§ 6-4. Execution of Articles of Incorporation. ⁵

The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and the Secretary, of this township are authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of this township, Articles of Incorporation for said Authority.⁶

§ 6-5. Publication of notice.

The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and the Secretary of this township further are directed to cause notice of the substance of this Article, including the substance of the foregoing Articles of Incorporation, and of the proposed filing of such Articles of Incorporation to be published as required by the Act.⁷

§ 6-6. Incorporation of Authority.

The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and the Secretary of this township further are directed to cause such Articles of Incorporation, together with the necessary proofs of publication, to be filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and to do all other acts and things necessary or appropriate to effect the incorporation of such Authority, including payment of any filing fees required in connection therewith.⁸

§ 6-7. Purpose.

The enactment of this Article is deemed necessary for the benefit and preservation of the public health, peace, comfort and general welfare of, and will increase the prosperity of, the citizens of this township.
